B ROBERT PENN WARREN BIRTHPLACE MUSEUM

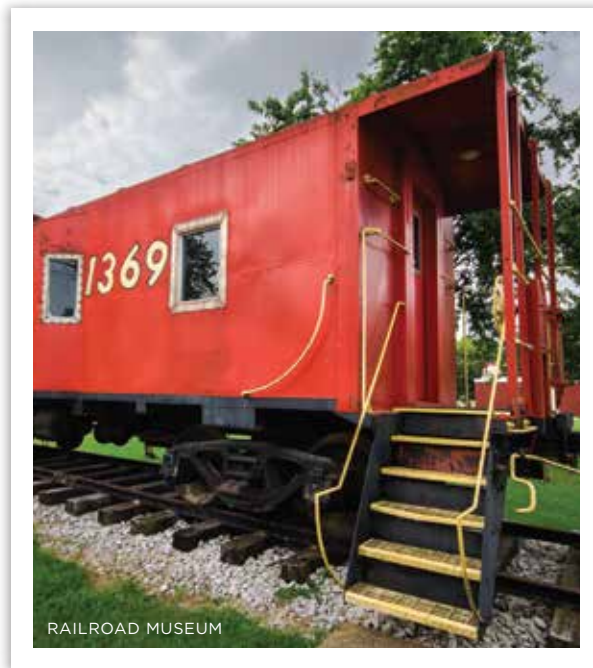

ROBERT PENN WARREN BIRTHPLACE MUSEUM

GUTHRIE, KENTUCKY. From stagecoaches to railroads, Guthrie has played an important part in transportation from the 1820's until today because of its central location to major cities. Major John Gray's stagecoach empire established a central location in Guthrie, spreading out to amass over 150 horses and multiple hotels.

INCORPORATED IN 1867, Guthrie is named for John James Guthrie, who was president of the L&N Railroad System at the time. The L&N Railroad System created the major switch-track that made Guthrie a boomtown featuring hotels, saloons and elaborate homes. Guthrie boasts notable visitors such as President Roosevelt, Jesse James, Jenny Lind and countless other important figures of the late 19th Century. Guthrie is probably best known for being the home of the first poet laureate of the United States of America, Robert Penn Warren, whose birthplace still remains near downtown. Warren's novel *Night Rider* fictionalized the Black Patch Wars fought in and around Guthrie over tobacco prices. The Stage Coach Inn in Guthrie is also known as a significant stop along the route of the Trail of Tears.
